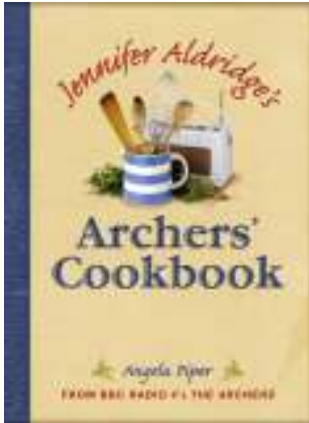

Each seasonal section features breakfast, lunch, teatime and dinner dishes, and each recipe includes metric and imperial measurements and step-by-step instructions.
